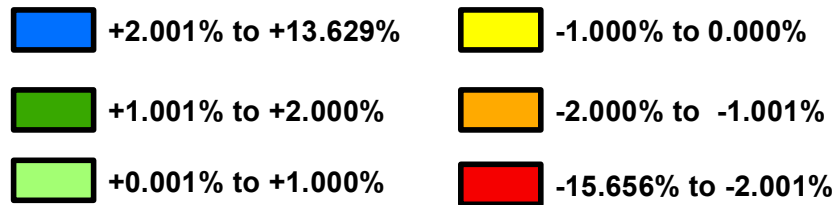
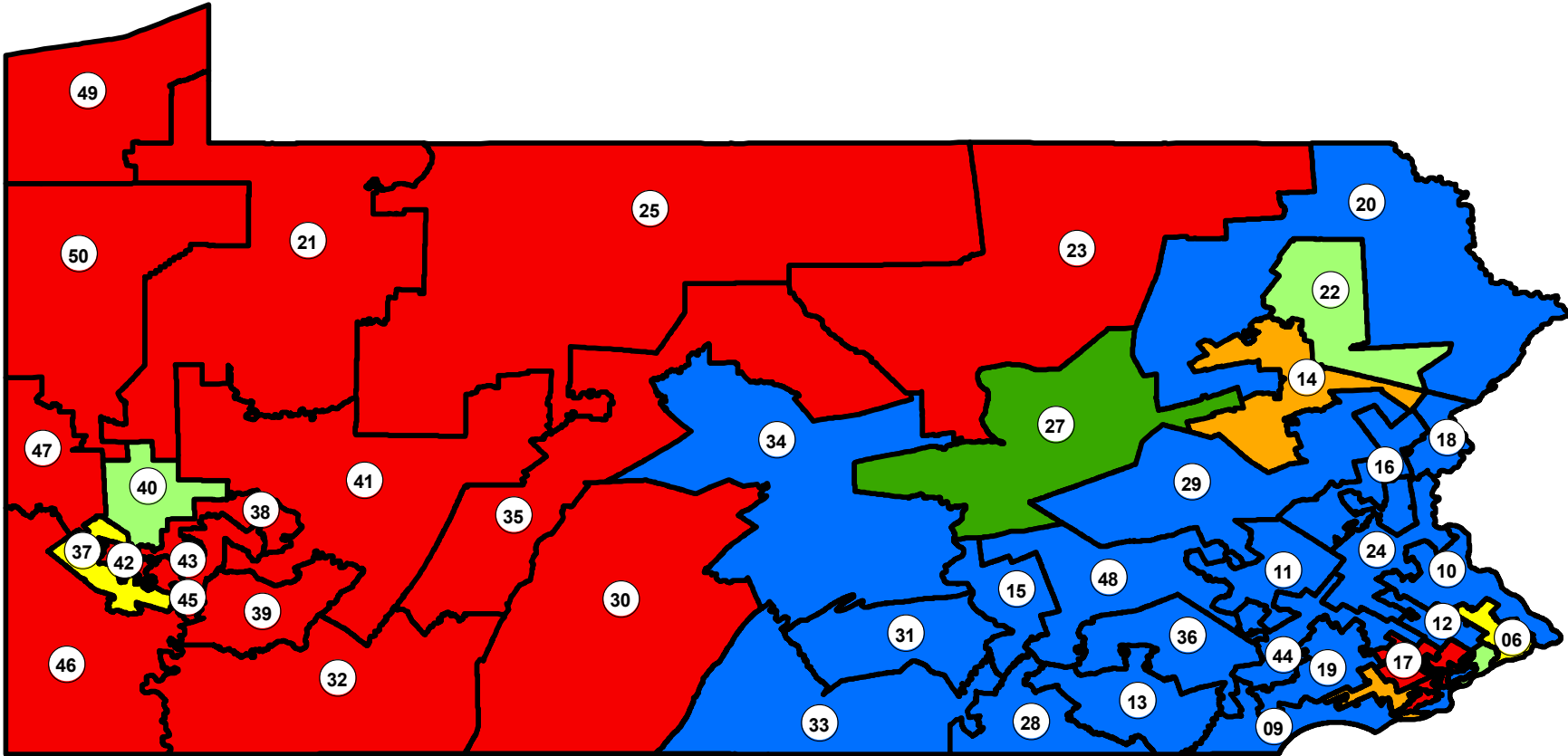


# Relative Deviation of 2001 Senate Districts, 2010 Adjusted Census Data Based on an Ideal Senate District Population of 254,048
